SERMON TITLE: God's Word Can Be Trusted

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE

Psalm 19:7-9

The law of the LORD is perfect, restoring the soul;
The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.

⁸The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart;
The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.

⁹The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever;
The judgments of the LORD are true; they are righteous altogether.

SUMMARY STATEMENT

God can be trusted, so God's word can be trusted. The Bible is God's word, so God's word can be trusted.

INTRODUCTION

The psalmist uses six (6) expressions to communicate that God's word can be trusted:

Point #1

God's word can be trusted because it is *infallible*.

(Psalm 19:7a)

The law of the LORD is perfect, restoring the soul;

Point #2

God's word can be trusted because it is *unimpeachable*.

Psalm 19:7b

The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.

Point #3

God's word can be trusted because it is *irreproachable*.

Psalm 19:8a

⁸ The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart;

Point #4

God's word can be trusted because it is *impeccable*.

Psalm 19:8b

The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.

Point #5

God's word can be trusted because it is *indelible*.

Psalm 19:9a

⁹ The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever;

Point #6

God's word can be trusted because it is *irrefutable*.

Psalm 19:9b

The judgments of the LORD are true; they are righteous altogether.
